Do you want to learn how to grow seed and breed new vegetable varieties for organic production? Join nationally renowned researchers for this one-day classroom and field based workshop intended for farmers, educators, and agricultural students.

Instruction will include: Seed biology fundamentals; harvesting, processing, and storing seed; population size and isolation requirements; managing pathogens during seed production and after harvest; and on-farm variety trialing and participatory breeding techniques.

We'll also connect with chefs to develop and identify varieties that shine in the kitchen. The morning classroom portion will be held at the Daniel Turf Center. We'll head to the field at The Student Farm in the afternoon to tour and taste test advanced carrot and tomato breeding populations.
